Information about the course

- ~ £2100 in total for three weeks of stay (includes breakfast meals). The flight ticket is not included.
- Winter and summer options available.
- Three field trips in total, one every friday.
- Optional activities every weekend.
- Access to facilities such as the swimming pool, gym and library.
- You will be assigned to either the beginner, intermediate or advanced class, on the first day of classes.
- Breakfast is served from 07:30, classes start at 09:00 and finish at different times during the afternoon, but usually no later than 15:30. Curfew is at 23:00.

My experiences and some advice

- Exchange most of your spending money before you arrive in Japan.
- Bringing your laptop will save you a lot of trouble later when it comes to *spoiler* final presentations.
- Get a Suica card on the day that you arrive, as it will be a life saver when travelling around Tokyo.
- The train system is not that scary.
- Get yourself connected to the internet.
- Use the free bus from the Niiza campus to get to either Shiki or Niiza stations.
- Don't be afraid to use your Japanese as you're exploring Japan in your free time.
